

Introduction:

Swindon Town FC Community Foundation endeavours to work with its staff and stakeholders to ensure that we create a sustainable future for everyone, by tackling climate change. - Work alongside Swindon Town Football Club, to continually explore ways to reduce our environmental impact.
- Take into account ethical and social issues, biodiversity and sustainability when making all strategic and operational decisions taking into consideration the UN Sustainable Development Goals.
- Encourage our staff and participants to explore behavioural changes and lifestyle decisions to minimise environmental impact.
- Avoid working in partnership with organisations whose ideology runs counter to our environmental beliefs and policies.
- Comply with environmental legislation with a focus on reducing pollution
- Endeavour to operate Foundation Park in a manner that minimises environmental impact.
- Explore ways to reduce waste in the running of the Foundation Park café.

How this will be achieved:

- Formation of an Environmental sustainability working group, engaging with interested members of staff and volunteers. This group will meet on a quarterly basis to discuss progress towards the Foundation's Environmental Sustainability Action Plan.
- The appointment of an Environmental Sustainability Lead on the Board of Trustees, responsible for monitoring progress against the action plan and ensuring environmental sustainability topics are on the agenda of board meetings.
- The appointment of an Environmental Sustainability Lead within the Senior Management team responsible for developing the Environmental Sustainability action plan and monitoring the progress towards it.

Responsibility and Review

The following Board and staff members have direct responsibility for this Policy and for the promotion of sustainability across all operations in accordance with this policy:
