Participant Code of Conduct

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player you have a big part to play, Swindon Town FC Community Foundation is asking every player to follow a code of conduct.

Obligations towards the game a player should:

- Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.
- Play fairly, I won't cheat, complain or waste time.
- Respect my team mates, the other team, the referee and my coach, don't use comments based on race, religion, gender or ability.
- Play by the rules, as directed by the referee.
- Listen and respond to what my coach tells me.
- Talk to the Foundation safeguarding officer (Shane Hewlett) if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.
- Remove all jewellery when playing in training and matches
- Be of a smart appearance whilst representing Swindon Town Football Club.

Obligations away from the game a player should:

- Respect my team mates at school or in other social environments.
- Not use social media as a platform for bullying or derogatory comments, either publicly or by private message.
- Not use social media to post negative comments about the staff, team or opposition teams of Swindon Town FC Community Foundation.
- Take a screen shot of any negative comments directed towards me and talk to Shane Hewlett (Foundation safeguarding officer) in the first instance if I am unhappy.
- If a team member tells me something in confidence that I feel a member of staff should be made aware of, I will explain that I have to share this information with the Foundation's safeguarding officer (Shane Hewlett) so that it can be dealt with appropriately.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team mates, the other team, referee or team manager.
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club.
- Be dropped or substituted.
- Be suspended from training.
- Not be allowed to travel as part of an organised trip.
- Be required to leave the centre.

In addition:

- My Club, County FA or the FA will make my parents or carers aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct.
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.

I WILL:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Respect the Referee's decisions even when you don't agree with them
- Appreciate good play from whatever team it comes from
- Remain behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Support positively and offer players encouragement not criticism
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour I understand that if I do

not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken:

I MAY BE:

- Issued with a verbal warning from Swindon Town FC Community Foundation
- Required to meet with the club, league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the Swindon Town FC Community Foundation Safeguarding Officer
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Obliged to leave the match venue by Swindon Town FC Community Foundation
- Requested by Swindon Town FC Community Foundation not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the Swindon Town FC Community Foundation along with any dependents.

IN ADDITION:

• The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/or suspension for Swindon Town FC Community Foundation
